



Title: The Windsor Way

Estimated time: 4 days

Grade Level(s): High School

Objectives

- Students will understand the character traits of the Windsor Way
- Students will make oral presentation to any school stakeholder as to the meaning of their trait. Students will work together in a group setting to complete a task.

Core Values

Respect, positive attitude, responsibility, honesty, self-discipline and compassion

Materials (include links & resources when applicable)

- Assigned character trait.
- Computer with internet access for research.
- All other materials will be at student request depending on their presentation type.

Procedure

Students are assigned a Windsor Way trait and given time to research and plan. Students will work together to create a 3-5 minute presentation to demonstrate their trait. The trait must be able to be explained to a wide variety of audiences. The presentations could be modified based on the audience. Students may need to present the material to an elementary classroom one day then give the presentation to the Rotary Club the next day.

Evaluation

The presentation will be graded on a rubric. The four areas of assessment criteria include overview, style, activity and team roles. Grading scale ranges from "awesome, good job, it's okay and did you even try?"
