IMPORTANT: For each photo, add a two sentence caption. 1) 1st Sentence should describe the events in the photo without being obvious. e.g. "The sixth grade character council collected food for the homeless." 2) 2nd sentence should reveal additional information that adds context to the photo. e.g. "They raised a record 2,000 pounds of food."
